Aim of the meeting :

The new EU legislation on the marketing & use of feed Regulation (EC) N° 767/2009 has been implemented on September 2010. It is therefore of key relevance to operators and authorities in Russia and the EU to obtain a clear understanding of the new obligations as part of the ongoing harmonisation efforts on feed and food safety legislation requirements under the European Neighbourhood Policy to address problems in cross-border trade of feed and livestock products while maintaining a high level of Public Health protection.

At the same time, FVO mission reports have pointed to implementation problems of the feed hygiene Regulation (EC) N° 183/2005 in particular in the area of HACCP implementation. The workshop should therefore provide guidance on how these problems could be solved both at the level of official controls & feed operators.
